DRAGON BOAT RACING

DETAILS

Originating from China over 2000 years ago, the history of dragon boat racing is steeped in a magical yet heroic myth, dragon boat racing has become the world's fastest growing water sport.

Dragon boats are 12 meters long decorated with a traditional dragons' head, tail and drum. Each boat can have between 10 and 16 paddlers providing the power, a drummer to beat a steady rhythm, and a helm to steer. The dragons are raced against each other in a spectacular energetic display.

No previous experience of dragon boat racing is required as full training and safety briefings will be provided on the day. A minimum of 14 people is required, with a maximum of 1,000 plus people for the larger team building events.

Each team building event consists of several teams, with the number of members in a team ranging from 11 – 17 people. Each team has a drummer, to beat a steady rhythm and therefore an odd number is required for one person to be the drummer.

Events range in size from 2 teams (14 people) to 60 teams (1,020 people) per one-day event.

Teams have a minimum of 2 races, where they will race against other teams over a 200-meter racecourse. The fastest teams go through to the Grand Final.

The winning teams will be awarded specially designed Dragon Boat medals and the winning trophy!
